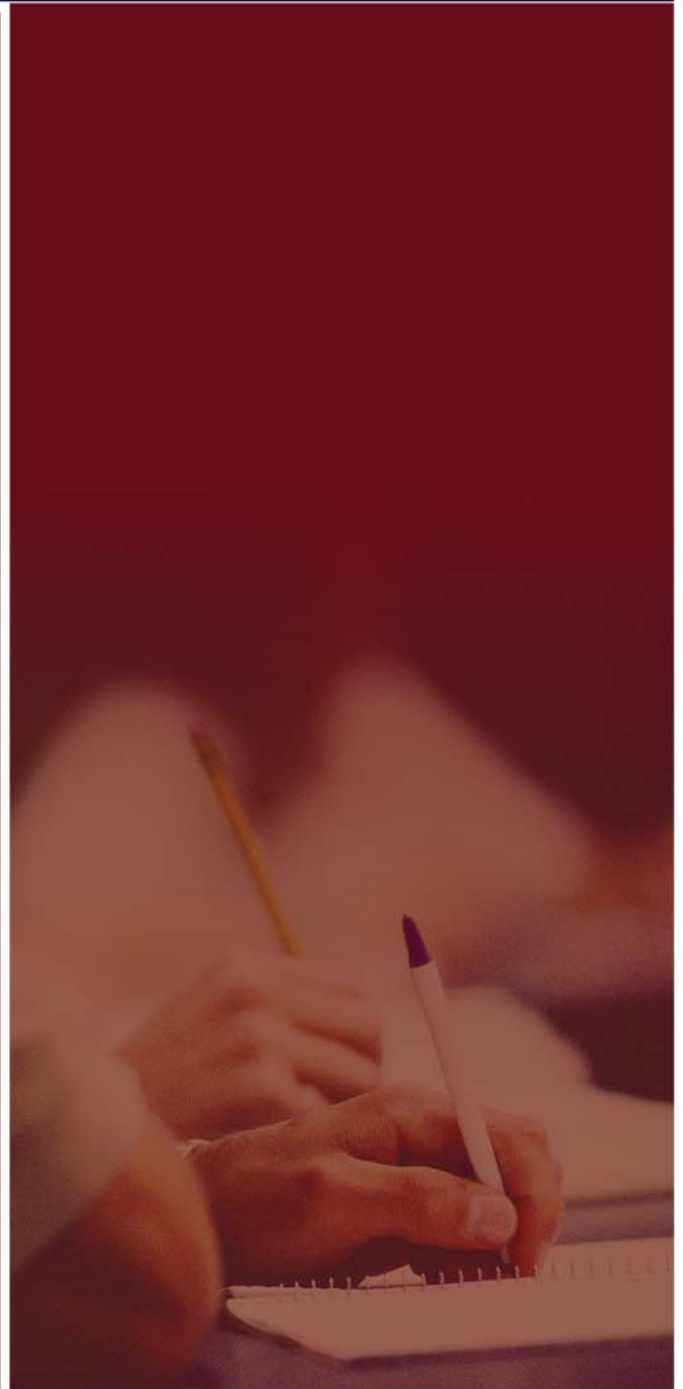

INTRODUCTION

Every year, the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission Office of Research and Technology compiles a listing of West Virginia's college going rates by county and high school. This report would not be possible without the gracious hard work and contributions from the colleges and universities, high schools, county superintendents, and the West Virginia Department of Education.

The improvement of literacy rates, educational levels, and college going rates are important goals for the betterment of the State and its economy. The college going rate echoes the successes of the Governor, legislators, government agencies, students, and parents in contributing to the State's education system as a whole. Success in this area is hard-won through diligence and constant attention. The attached report makes an effort to document progress to identify areas for continued efforts for improvement.

West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2004

- Of the 18,027 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2003-04, an estimated 10,928 **(60.6%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the Fall 2004 semester. This reflects a **1.2% increase** over the 2003 rate of 59.40%.
- 9,167 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (43.6%), independent (4.3%), or degree-granting proprietary (3.0%) colleges or universities. Year-to-year percentage increases were noted in the public sector and, marginally, in the proprietary and out-of-state sectors. A slight decrease was experienced by the independent colleges and universities. This generates an **in-state college going rate of 50.9%**. This is a **1.1% increase** over last year's figure of 49.8%.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in Fall 2004, it is estimated that another 1,761 **(9.8%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects a **0.1% increase** from 2003's figure of 9.6%.
- The most current national data from 2002 showed a 54.0% college enrollment rate for West Virginia high school graduates, compared to the 56.6% national average, thereby narrowing the gap between the two since 2000.

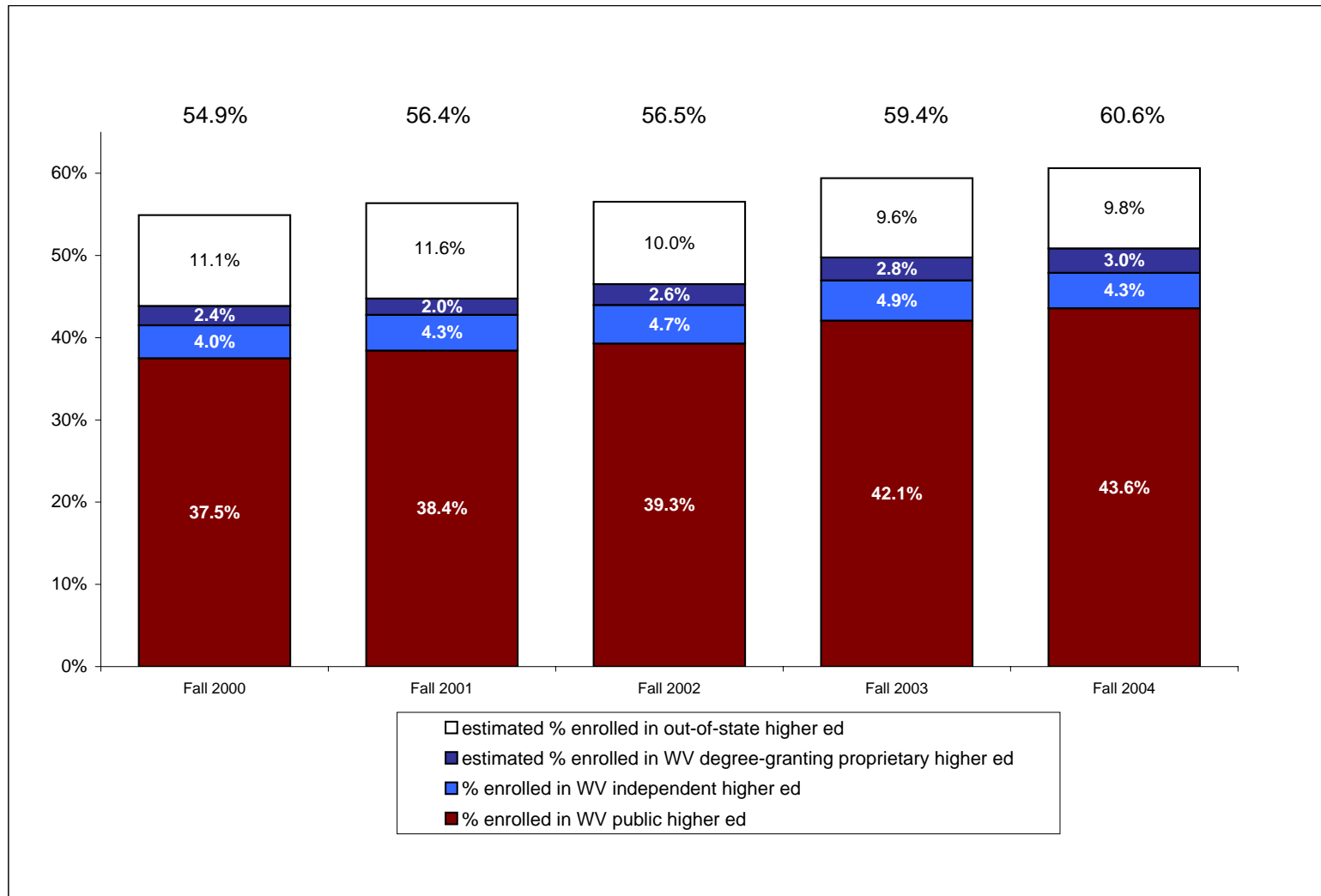

2000-2004**

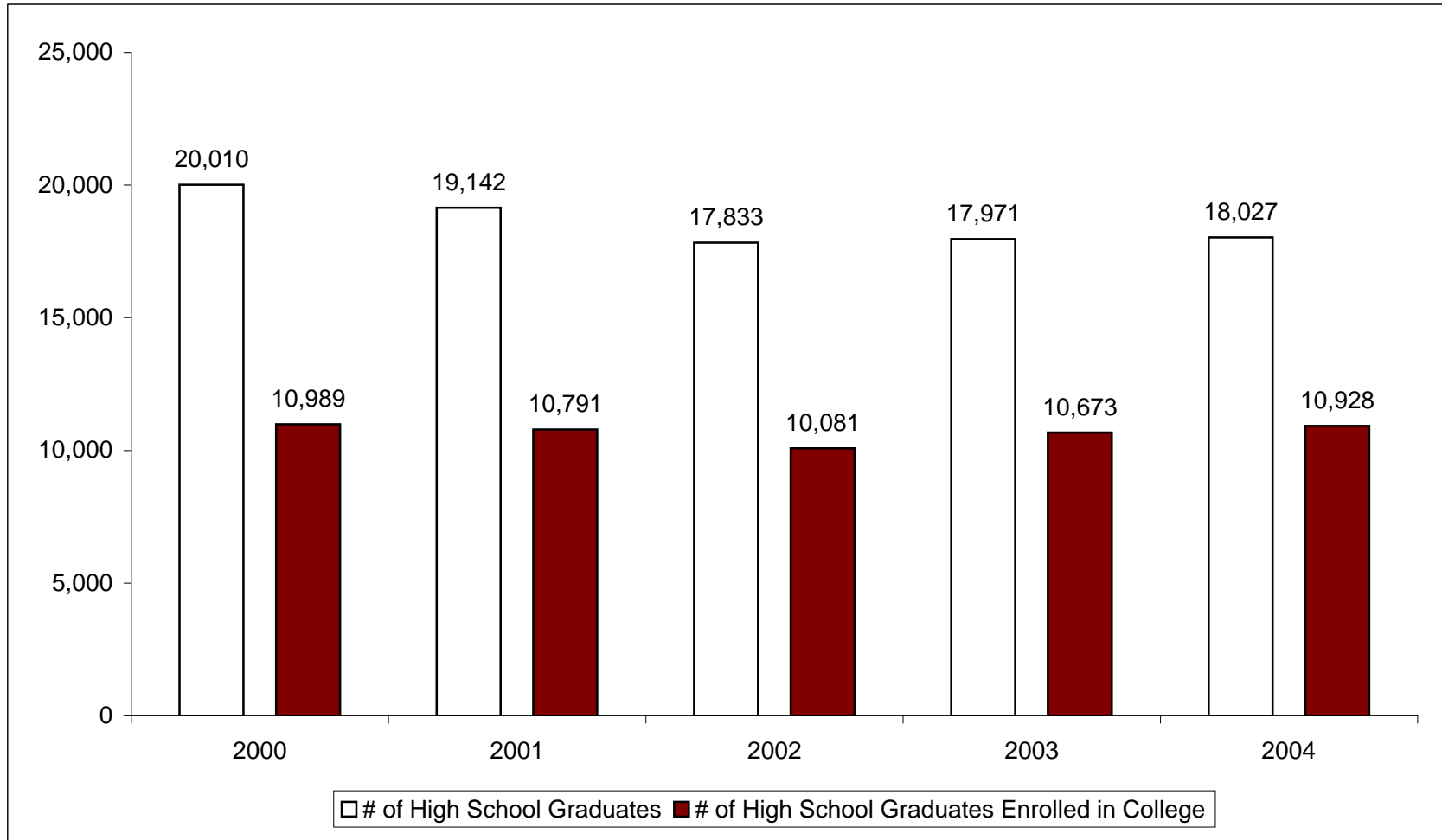
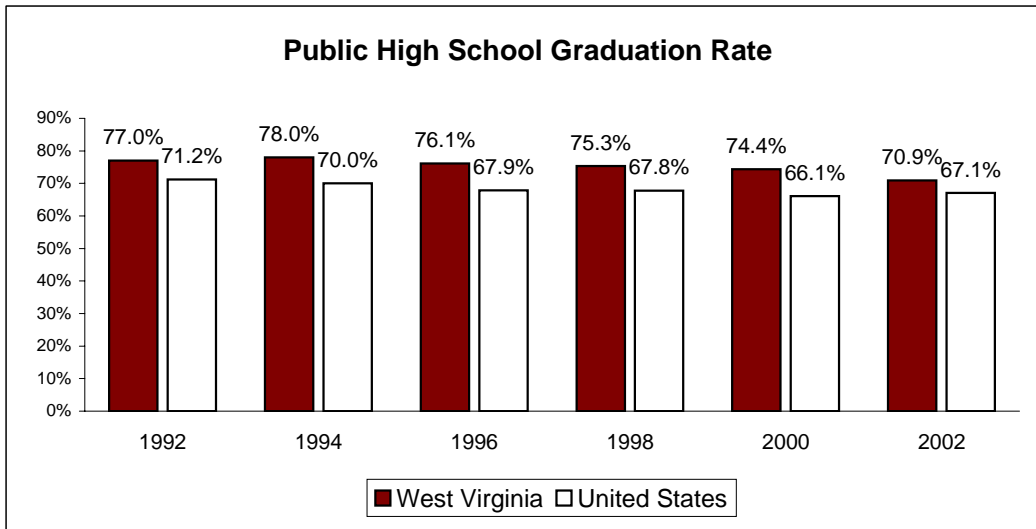
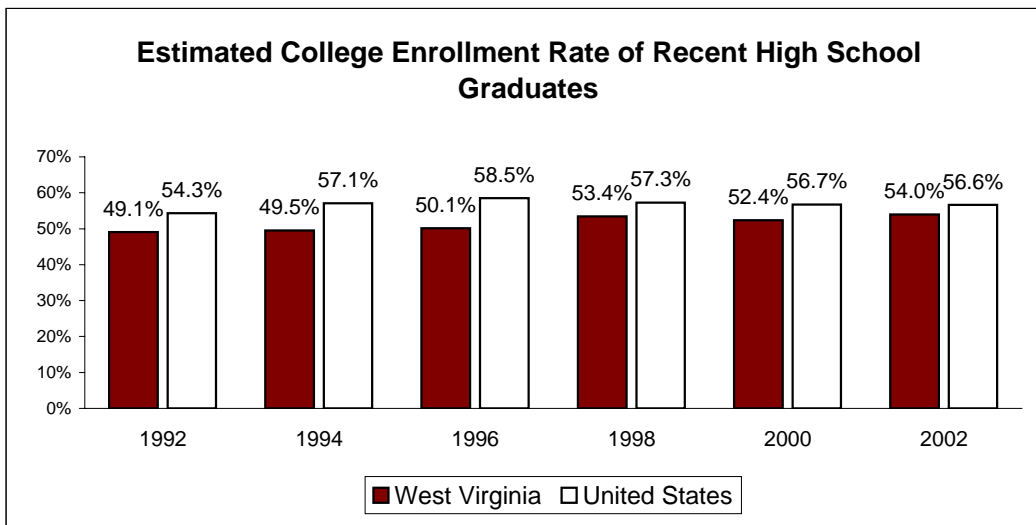


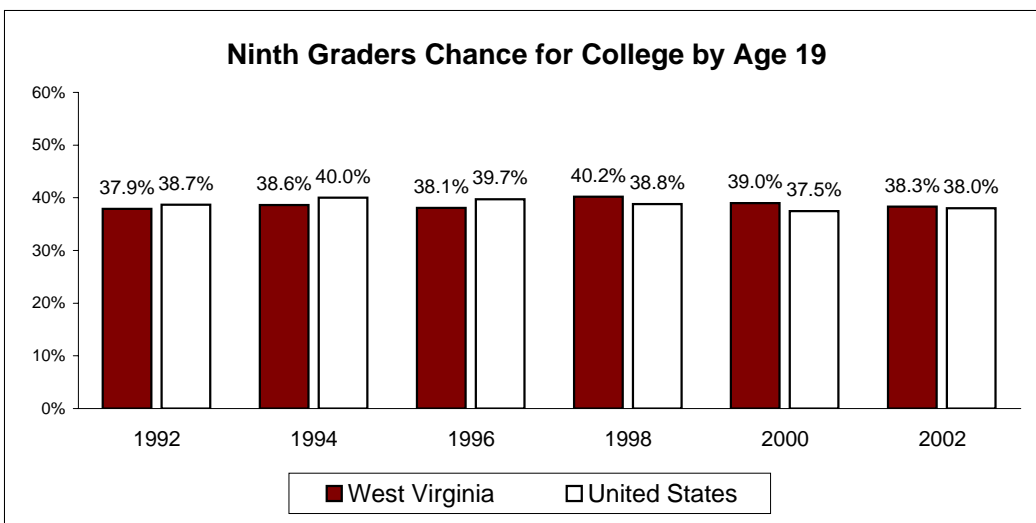
