# Summer/Fall offerings for 2014:

- 18 sections of co-requisite English
- 5 sections of co-requisite non-STEM math
- Summer Bridge Program

# Issues to be resolved:

- Math must develop a STEM co-requisite course for fall 2015
- Create a 100-level quantitative reasoning course to replace MTH 098 (below 14 math ACT)
- Make sure faculty workload adjustments are fair and reasonable

- Fall to Fall Retention
- Pass rates in co-req courses
- Pass rates in gateway courses
- Over-all retention and graduation rates
