Background

- West Virginia joins 34 other U.S. states and territories in the "Alliance of States" in Complete College America, known as CCA.
- CCA was established as a nonprofit in 2009 to work with states to significantly increase the number of Americans with career certificates or college degrees.
- While the U.S. has met its goal of creating more opportunities for students to enroll in college, nationally the graduation rate has not matched the pace of enrollment. CCA conducts research and creates programs designed to increase the number of students who complete college and graduate on time.
- The annual convening provides an opportunity for each Alliance member to present successes and discuss how the CCA initiatives are being implemented. Attendance at this event is supported by CCA funding.

CCA'S GAME CHANGERS

CCA has developed five key initiatives to improve college completion rates, which in turn puts more of our young people in the workforce, while reducing student loan debt:

- 1. Performance Funding
- 2. Corequisite Remediation
- 3. 15 Credit Hours Per Semester (15 to Finish)
- 4. Structured Schedules
- 5. Guided Pathways to Success

Much of the 2014 annual convening focused on the Guided Pathways to Success, which places students into very structured degree plans, rather than individual courses.

- Starting in high school, a guided pathway program would help map out their planned program of study to community college and onward to a four-year program.
- Maps out every semester of study for the entire degree and guarantees that milestone courses will be available when needed.
- Students choose coherent programs, not random, individual choices. It's like a "PACKAGED DEAL" choice of majors, rather than random courses toward completion.
- Rather than looking at college degree completion on a year-to-year basis, it maps it out class by class, identifying CRITICAL path courses needed each semester.
- Helps students with informed choices about their plans of study.
- Provides for "INTRUSIVE" and "just-in-time" advising.
 - o Targeted support for each student that is customized to meet the needs of each student.
 - o Early warning systems for example, failure of a key exam or project during the semester, which would allow intervention when it is most needed.

West Virginia has begun implementing several elements of these initiatives:

DegreeWorks Software

- Available to all colleges and universities in the state
- Tracks academic achievement and compares where a student currently stands with the requirements for his or her selected major.
- Students and their advisers can easily log in and check their most up-to-date progress toward a degree.
- Students can review the requirements already completed, and help plan courses they should take to complete their degree on time.
- One of the most powerful features is the "What If" function that allows students to see how changing a major or dropping a course will affect their time to degree completion.
- Great tool for students and advisers. Parents love it.
- Marshall, WVU and all regional institutions are now on board with DegreeWorks, in various stages of implementation. All but one community college is operational with the software, however, training is expensive and a key part of full-scale implementation, especially at the smaller colleges.

15 to Finish

- In the past 20 years or so, students have adhered to the belief that 12 credit hours per semester is a full load and that, by taking that many courses, they are on the correct path to graduation.
- While 12 hours does technically make a full-time student it does not equate to graduating in two years or four years.

- In West Virginia, once you reach full-time (12 hours), it costs no more in tuition to take additional credit hours.
- 2-year programs require a minimum of 60 credit hours to graduate.
- 4-year programs require a minimum of 120 hours.
- Taking just 12 hours per semester automatically extends a four-year degree to five years and a two-year degree to 2.5 years. That's if a student successfully completes all the requirements!
- Research shows that taking 15 hours each semester improves academic performance, reduces student loan debt and improves employment prospects by allowing students to begin their careers as soon as possible.
- As a matter of record, West Virginia's PROMISE Scholarship program requires recipients to complete and earn a minimum of **30** credit **hours** in each 12-month period.
- In 2014, the Commission and CCA kicked off the 15 to Finish campaign in West Virginia with all the four-year institutions represented.
- The Commission is providing our colleges and universities with the information and resources they need to encourage students to take a full course load of 15 hours, balance their schedules and graduate on time.

Co-requisite Remediation

- Nationally, in recent years, about 40 percent of students going to college have required remedial courses BEFORE being able to enroll in credit-bearing courses.
- For two-year colleges, the number of students in remedial courses is closer to 60 percent.
- For West Virginia community colleges, about 66 percent of first-time freshmen are in developmental education.
- **87 percent** of students who start in remediation NEVER GRADUATE.
- CCA believes that current postsecondary remedial education is failing to meet the needs of students and colleges.
- The solution could be **co-requisite remediation**:
 - o Start college students in college courses, not more high-school level classes.
 - o Remediation is provided as corequisite **ALONGSIDE** full-credit, college-level courses, not as a prerequisite to them.
 - This enables students to take the gateway courses toward degree completion, rather than simply completing courses that have time and again proven unsuccessful in the path toward a degree.
- For the West Virginia Council for Community and Technical College Education, we have gone headlong into **co-requisite developmental education in the last couple years.**
 - o In 2011, no co-reqs in math or English were offered.
 - o In 2014, only 30 percent of students were enrolled in traditional developmental math courses.
 - o In 2014, 41 percent of students are taking co-requisite remedial English.
 - o 100 PERCENT co-requisite remediation by fall of 2015.
- West Virginia CTC leaders and students have been featured presenters during the past two CCA conferences.

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• In August 2015, the Commission applied to become a member of CCA's Co-requisite to Scale initiative, which will focus on expanding co-req English and math courses in the public four-year institutions.

Other CCA-endorsed initiatives on tap for our colleges:

- Guided Pathways to Success
 - Math pathways aligning math to the degree. For many students, required higherlevel math courses, such as algebra, calculus and trigonometry, are serious obstacles to college success.
 - Math pathways provide an alternative for non-STEM majors to enroll in mathematics courses, such as statistics, which better align with most social science and professional degree programs.

Forward Progression with CCA Initiatives

- Continued collection of data that provides insight into key student success indicators.
- Continued implementation of DegreeWorks across all colleges and universities.
- Full implementation of co-requisite developmental education at community colleges and scaling to the baccalaureate institutions.
- Implementation of Guided Pathways to degree completion from high school onward.
- Marketing to students and parents the 15 to Finish program -- the importance of taking 15 credit hours each semester.
- Implementation of a variety of intrusive advising methods.
- Consider implementing outcomes-based funding measures for **NEW** investment in state public higher education as a model for potential future public funding.

Complete College America has been very pleased with the progress of these initiatives in West Virginia from the state level to individual institutions. As we continue to experiment with new degree "packages," enhanced advising and tutoring programs, we must gather and share the appropriate data and track the success of these "Game Changers."

Additional funding will be necessary to fully implement these programs. It takes more staff to focus on student outcomes and additional software and advisers to help ensure their success.

The results are very favorable in the states that present at the CCA conventions. We attend these conferences to learn how other states' programs can be adapted to our own colleges and institutions. In turn, the other states also learn from us.

It is clear that as the college-going rate has increased – a goal that we set and should continue to pursue – we also have an obligation to ensure the students who enter post-secondary education in West Virginia are finishing what they started.

The results will be increased student graduation rates, lower student loan debt and a stronger instate workforce pool that helps to attract and retain employers, and create better jobs for West Virginians.

Annual Report on Board of Governors Training

During the 2009 legislative session, the West Virginia Legislature enacted West Virginia Code §18B-1D-9 requiring the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission (Commission) to coordinate periodic training and development opportunities for members of institutional governing boards under the Commission's jurisdiction and the lay members of the Commission itself. Specifically, State Code requires that:

- Within six months of beginning service on a governing board, a board member must complete at least three hours of training and development relating to their duties as a board member. This provision is to be interpreted as applying only to those governing board members beginning service on or after July 1, 2009.
- With the exception of the student members of a governing board, each board member must complete at least six hours of training and development within every two years of service. This provision is to be interpreted as beginning on July 1, 2009 for those members already in office on July 1, 2009, or as beginning with the start of service date if appointed after July 1, 2009.
- The training and development is to address the following topics:
 - O State goals, objectives, and priorities for higher education;
 - O The accountability system for higher education set forth in West Virginia Code §18B-1D-1 et seq:

- o The general powers and duties of governing board members; and,
- o Ethical considerations arising from board membership.

To facilitate this process, the Commission sponsored various training opportunities and staff developed several forms, a comprehensive tracking system, and a special training section of the agency's website located at http://www.wvhepc.com/resources/training-for-boards-of-governors/.

Since July 2009, the Commission has hosted various training opportunities including, but not limited to, the following events:

- 2009 Board of Governors Summit, which provided nine hours of training credit;
- 2009 Finance Summit, which provided six hours of training credit;
- 2010 Board of Governors Summit, which provided nine hours of training credit;
- 2011 Capitalizing on the Foundation-Institution Partnership, which provided five hours of training credit;
- 2011 Strategic Finance, which provided five hours of training credit;
- 2012 Board of Governors Summit, which provided nine hours of training credit;
- 2013 Board of Governors Summit, which provided nine hours of training credit; and
- 2014 Board of Governors Summit, which provided nine hours of training credit.
- 2015 Board of Governors Summit, which provided nine hours of training credit.

The Commission's website also provides technology-based training credits. Certain sessions of this prior years' Board of Governors Summits were recorded and posted on the Commission's website, allowing board members who could not attend in person to receive credit for viewing the sessions online. In total, the Commission's website now has seven hours of online training opportunities.

As required by statute, each institutional board chair is to annually certify to the Commission by July 31 the number of hours of training and development each board member received during the preceding fiscal year. Additionally, by September 30, the Commission is to report to the Legislative Oversight Commission on Education Accountability on the training and development that Commission and board members received during the preceding fiscal year.

For the Fiscal Year 2015 reporting period beginning on July 1, 2014 and ending on June 30, 2015, annual certifications were received from all institutional board chairs and the Commission's chair with all current members in compliance. The attached spreadsheet details training credits for the current reporting periods for all Commission and institutional board members, with the exception of student members and ex-officio members of the Commission, who are exempt from training requirements. In most instances, when no credit hours are noted on the attachment, those members either have expired terms or still have time to complete training during their current two-year window.

RE: Annual Report on Council and Institutional Board of Governors Training

During the 2009 legislative session, the West Virginia Legislature enacted West Virginia Code §18B-1D-9 requiring the West Virginia Council for Community and Technical College Education (Council) to coordinate periodic training and development opportunities for members of institutional governing boards under the Council's jurisdiction and the lay members of the Council itself. Specifically, that Code requires that:

- Within six months of beginning service on a governing board, a board member must complete a minimum of three hours of training and development relating to their duties as a board member. This provision is to be interpreted as applying only to those governing board members beginning service on or after July 1, 2009.
- With the exception of the student members of a governing board, each board member must complete at least six hours of training and development within every two years of service. This provision is to be interpreted as beginning on July 1, 2009, for those members already in office or as beginning with the start of service date if appointed after July 1, 2009.
- The training and development is to address the following topics:
 - State goals, objectives and priorities for higher education;
 - The accountability system for higher education set forth in West Virginia Code §18B-1D-1 et seq;
 - The general powers and duties of governing board members; and,
 - Ethical considerations arising from board membership.

During the 2015 legislative session, the West Virginia Legislature amended the statute effective June 12, 2015. The Council will begin tracking hours earned using the amended statute beginning July 1, 2015.

The Council hosted the training activity listed below during the 2014-15 reporting period. In addition, institutions provided training or used a third party to conduct specialized training. Prior approval from the Chancellor's office is required if an institution wishes to offer training.

WV Community College Association / WV Association for Developmental Education Conference
 16 hours of training credit

As required by statute, each institutional board is to certify to the Council by July 31 of each year the number of hours of training and development each board member received during the preceding fiscal year. Additionally, the statute requires that by September 30 of each year the Council shall report to the Legislative Oversight Commission on Education Accountability on the training and development that members of the Council and the governing boards received during the preceding fiscal year.

For fiscal year 2015, annual certifications were received from all institutional board chairs and the Council's chair. Enclosed is a full report of the training hours earned by all institutional board members and Council lay members.




