
#### **National Enrollment Trends**

- College enrollment generally goes up during economic downturns and then declines as jobs return.
- Enrollment numbers nationally are particularly down for non-traditional students.
- The National Center for Education Statistics predicts that national college enrollment will increase at a very slow rate from 2010 to 2021.




#### **National Enrollment Trends**

Figure 1: Percent Change from Previous Year, Enrollment by Sector (Title IV, Degree-Granting Institutions)






#### WV High School Graduate Projections: 2010 to 2020







Enrollment increased 3.7% over fall 2015, and decreased 3.1% over fall 2011.









#### **Access and Success Initiatives**

- FAFSA and financial aid outreach, *prior-prior year*
- GEAR UP, College Foundation of West Virginia, and other high school outreach
- Focus on adult and low-income student populations
- Continued emphasis on student retention
- Expanding dual enrollment as a gateway to institutions
- 15 to Finish campaign, 6% increase in FT-FT freshmen
- Developmental education reform, corequisite to scale by 2018
