INTRODUCTION

Every year, the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission's Division of Policy and Planning compiles a listing of West Virginia's college going rates by county and high school. This report would not be possible without the gracious hard work and contributions from the colleges and universities, high schools, county superintendents, and the West Virginia Department of Education.

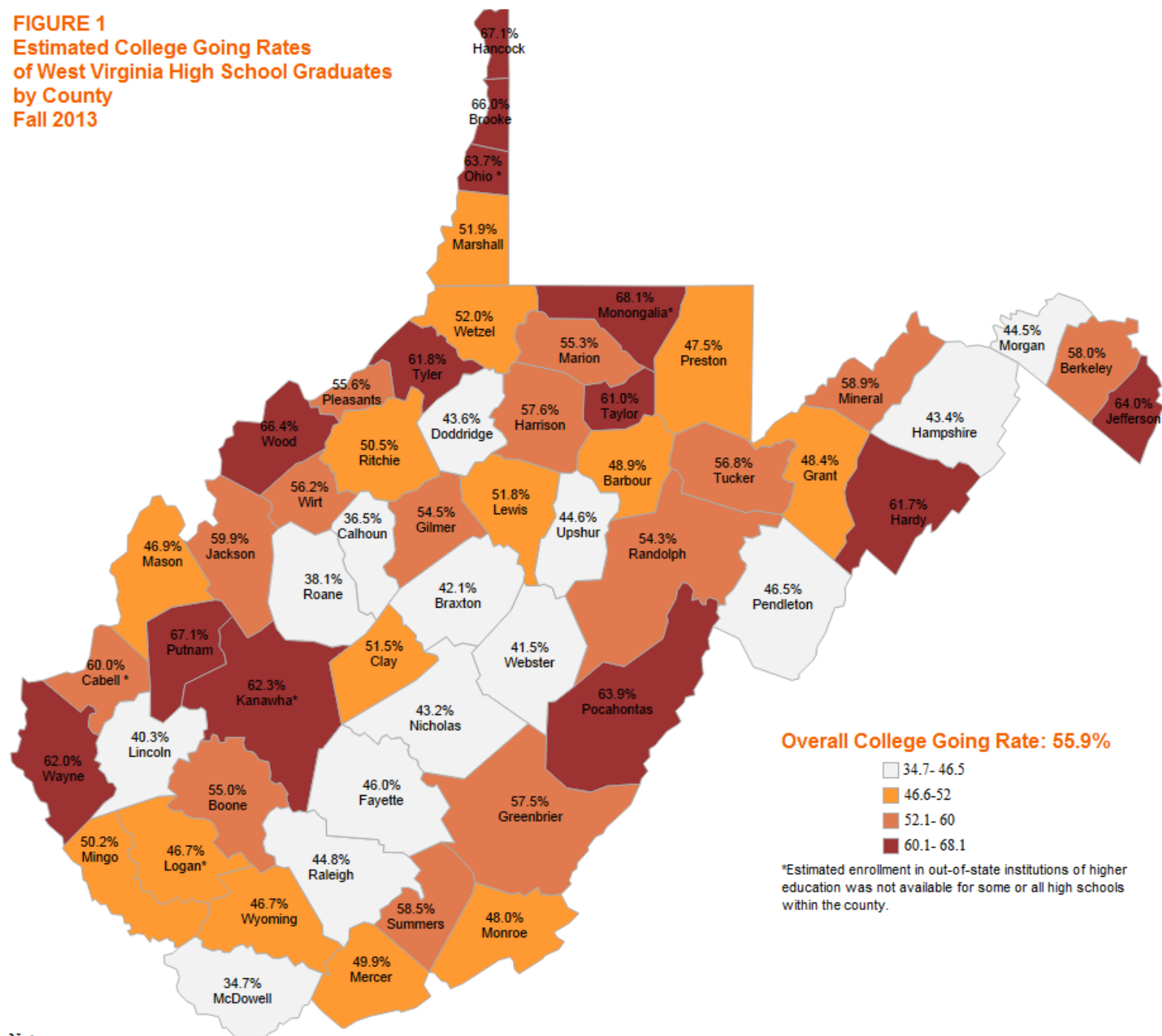
The improvement of literacy rates, educational levels, and college going rates are important goals for the betterment of the State and its economy. The college going rate echoes the successes of the Governor, legislators, government agencies, students, and parents in contributing to the State's education system as a whole. Success in this area is hard-won through diligence and constant attention. The attached report makes an effort to document progress to identify areas for continued efforts for improvement.

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West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2013

- Of the 18,600 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2012-13, an estimated 10,398 **(55.9%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the fall 2013 semester. This represents **a decrease of half a percentage point in the overall rate** since last year and the lowest overall rate since 2002. West Virginia public institutions of higher education enrolled slightly more recent high school graduates than in 2012; however, the increase in the number of graduates was even greater, thereby causing a slight decrease in the rate for this sector. West Virginia degree-granting proprietary institutions and out-of-state institutions experienced decreases, while West Virginia independent institutions experienced an increase in its rate.
- 8,966 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (43.0%), independent (4.2%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.1%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 48.2%**, which represents **a decrease of .2 percentage points over last year's figure**.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in fall 2013, it is estimated that another 1,432 **(7.7%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects a decrease of 0.3 of a percentage point over last year's figure.
- Although this is the fourth year in a row the overall college going *rate* has fallen, the degree to which it is falling is lessening. The *number* enrolled in higher education has gone up, but has been outpaced by the second straight year of a larger high school graduate population.

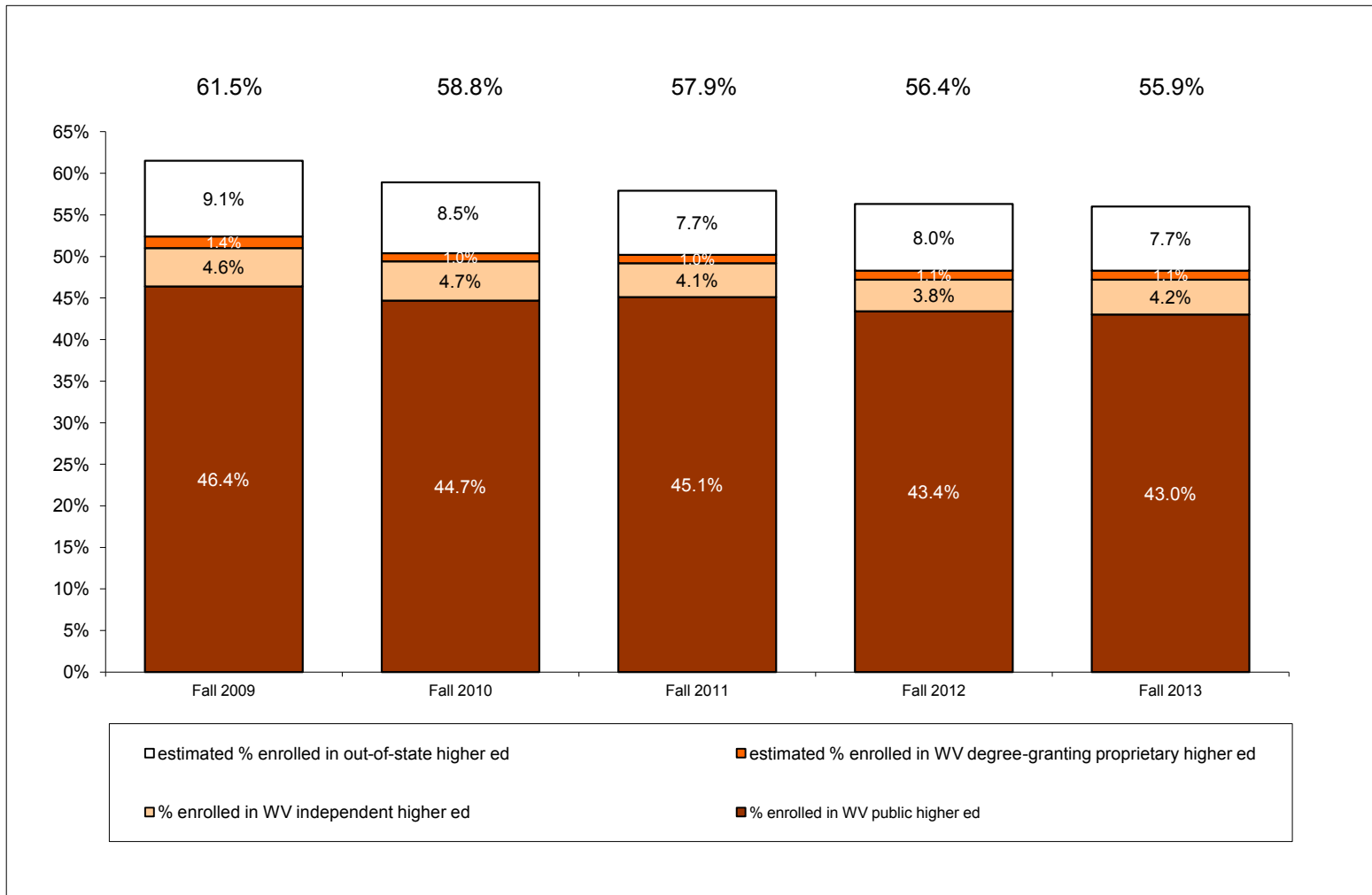

2009-2013

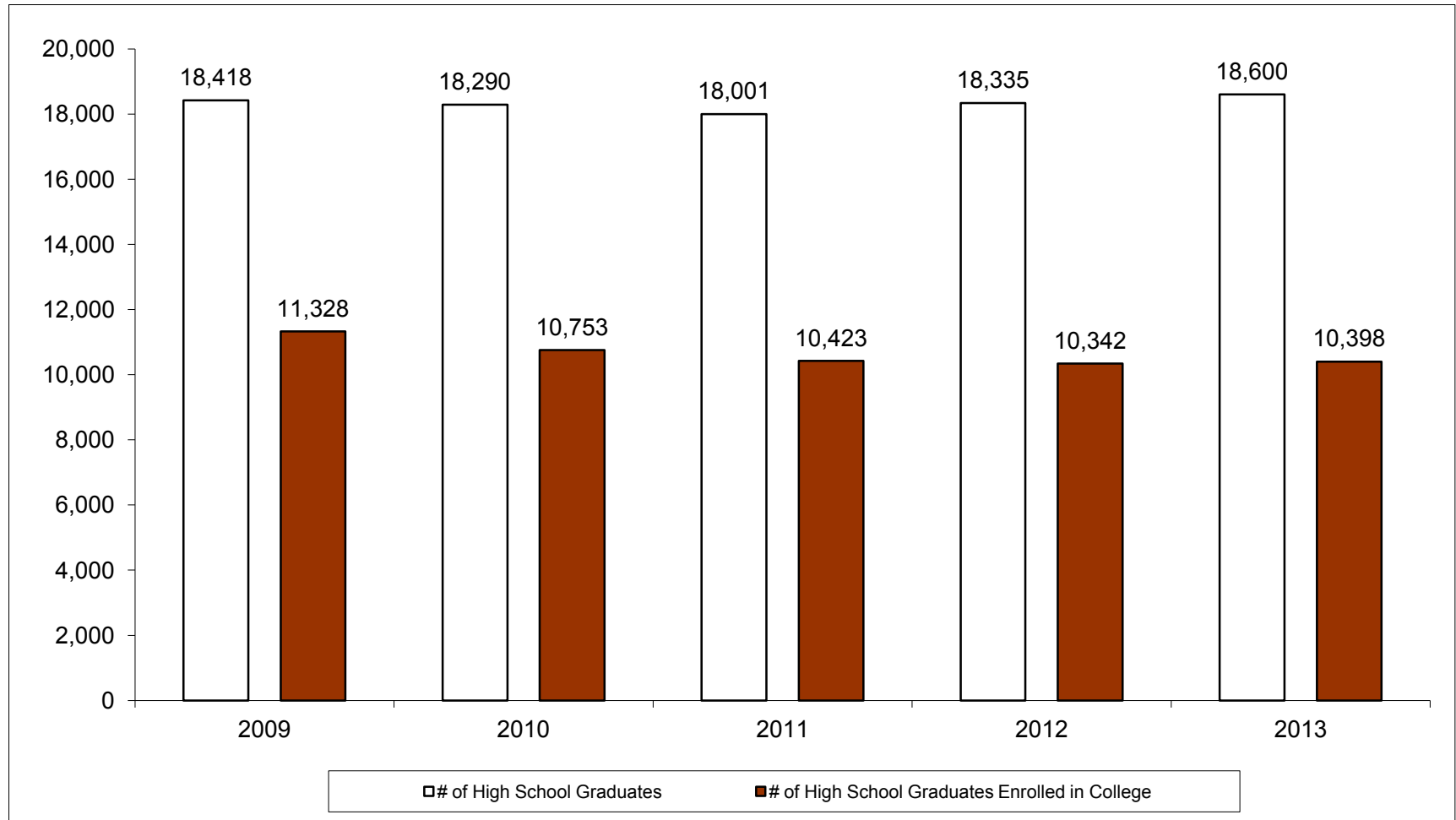
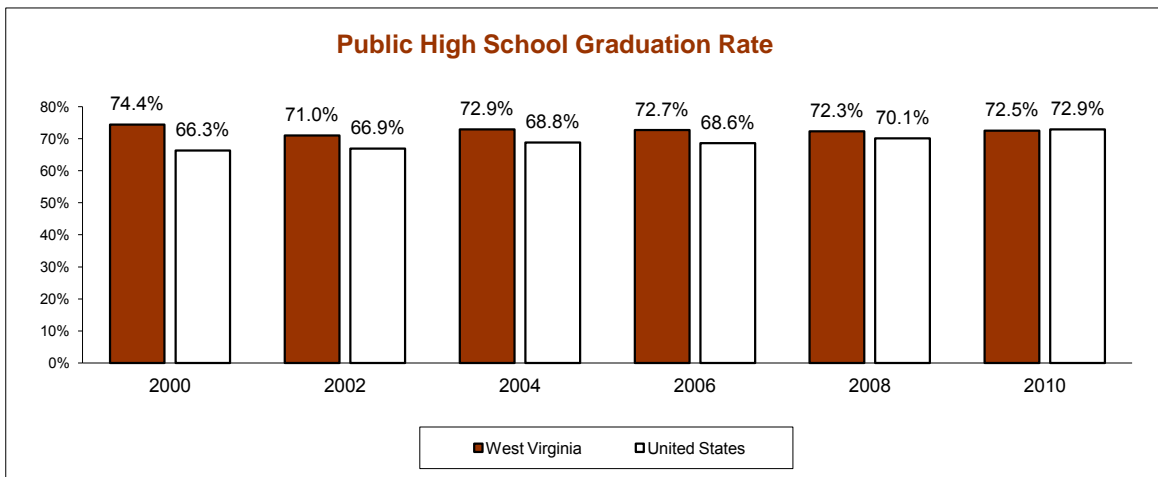
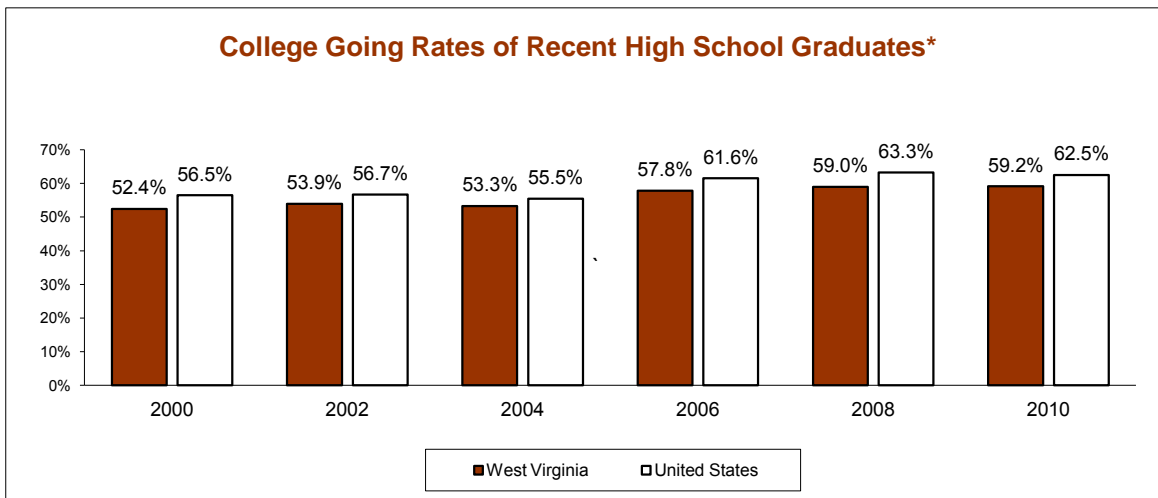

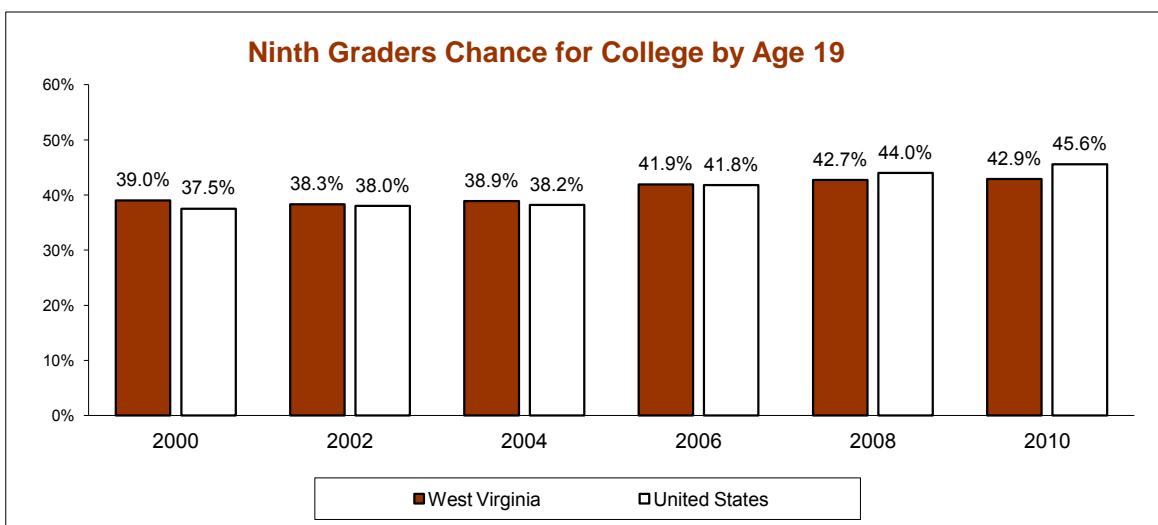
