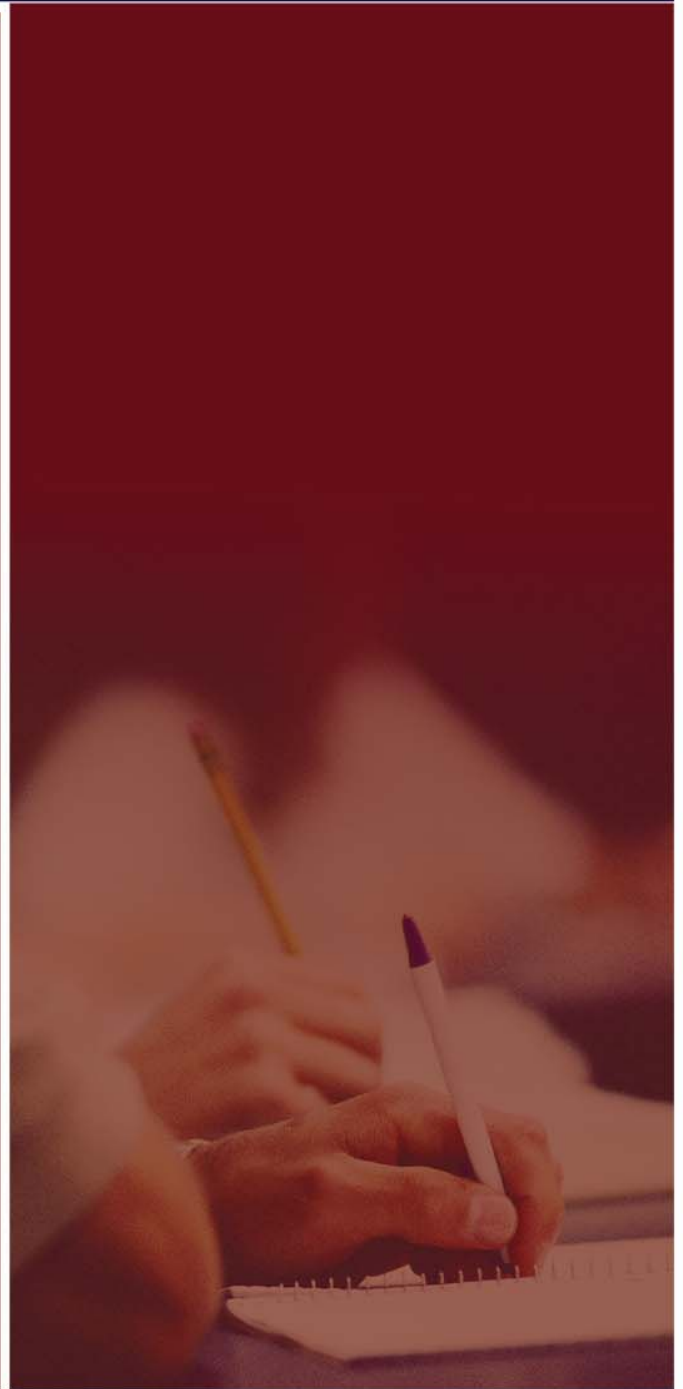

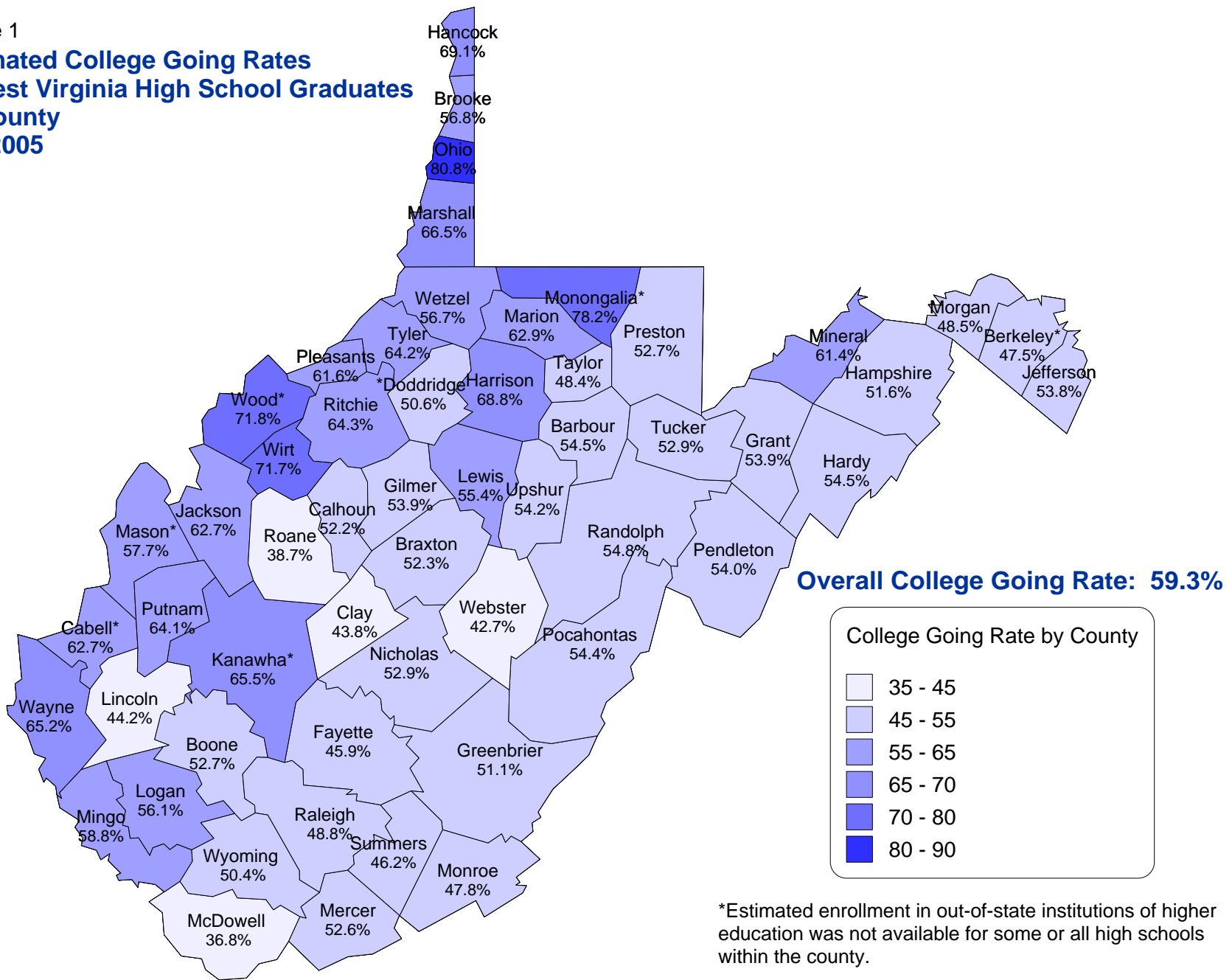

West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2005

- Of the 17,819 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2004-05, an estimated 10,568 **(59.3%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the Fall 2005 semester. There has been no increase or decrease in the overall rate since last year.
- 8,860 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (43.9%), independent (4.4%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.4%) colleges or universities. Slight year-to-year increases were noted in the public and independent sectors while a marginal decrease was experienced in the proprietary sector. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 49.7%**. This is a **0.2% increase** over last year's figure of 49.5%.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in Fall 2005, it is estimated that another 1,708 **(9.6%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects a **0.2% decrease** from 2004's figure of 9.8%.
- The most current national projected data showed a 54.1% college enrollment rate for West Virginia high school graduates, compared to the 55.4% national average, thereby producing the narrowest gap between the two in over a decade.

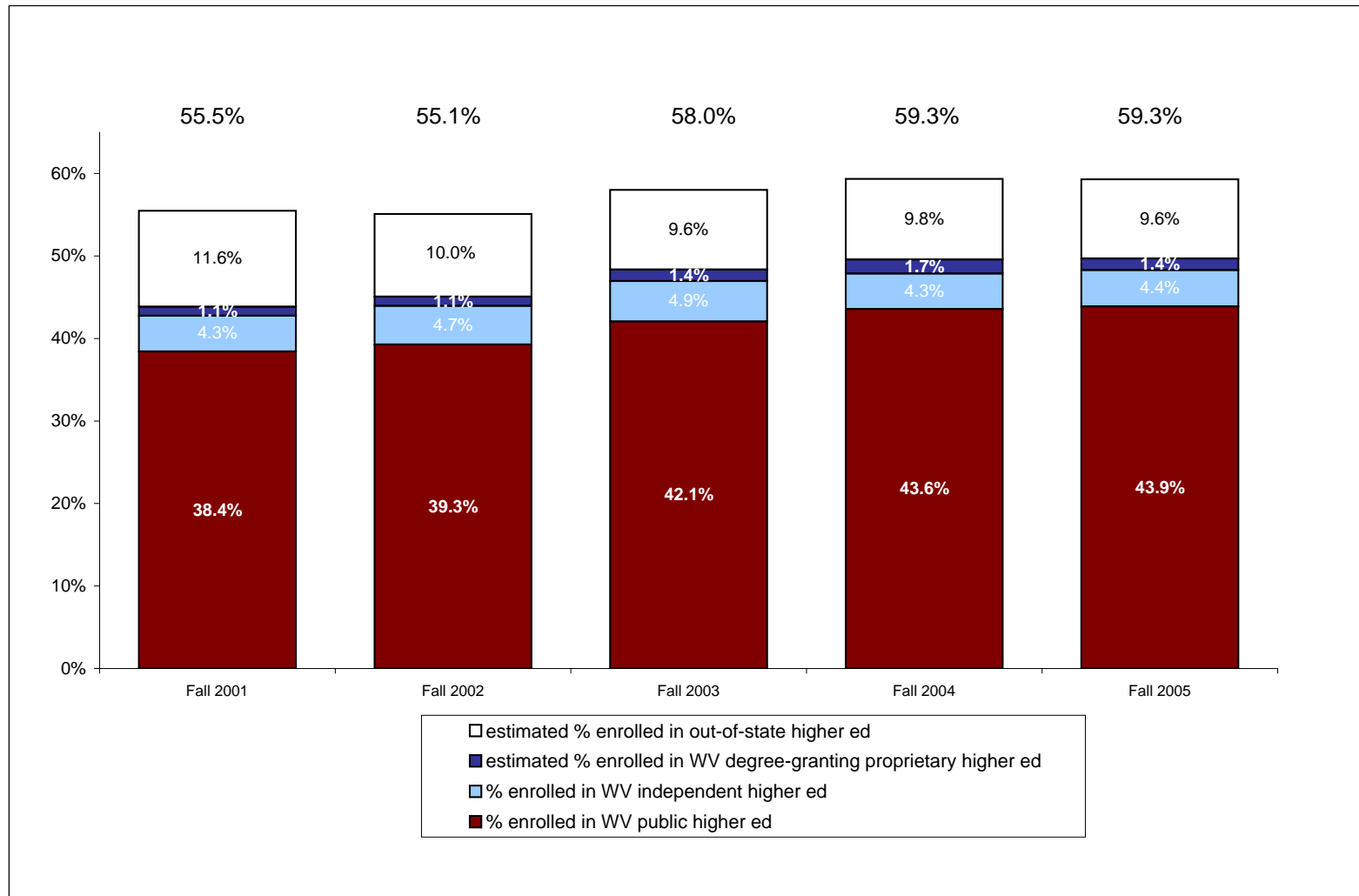

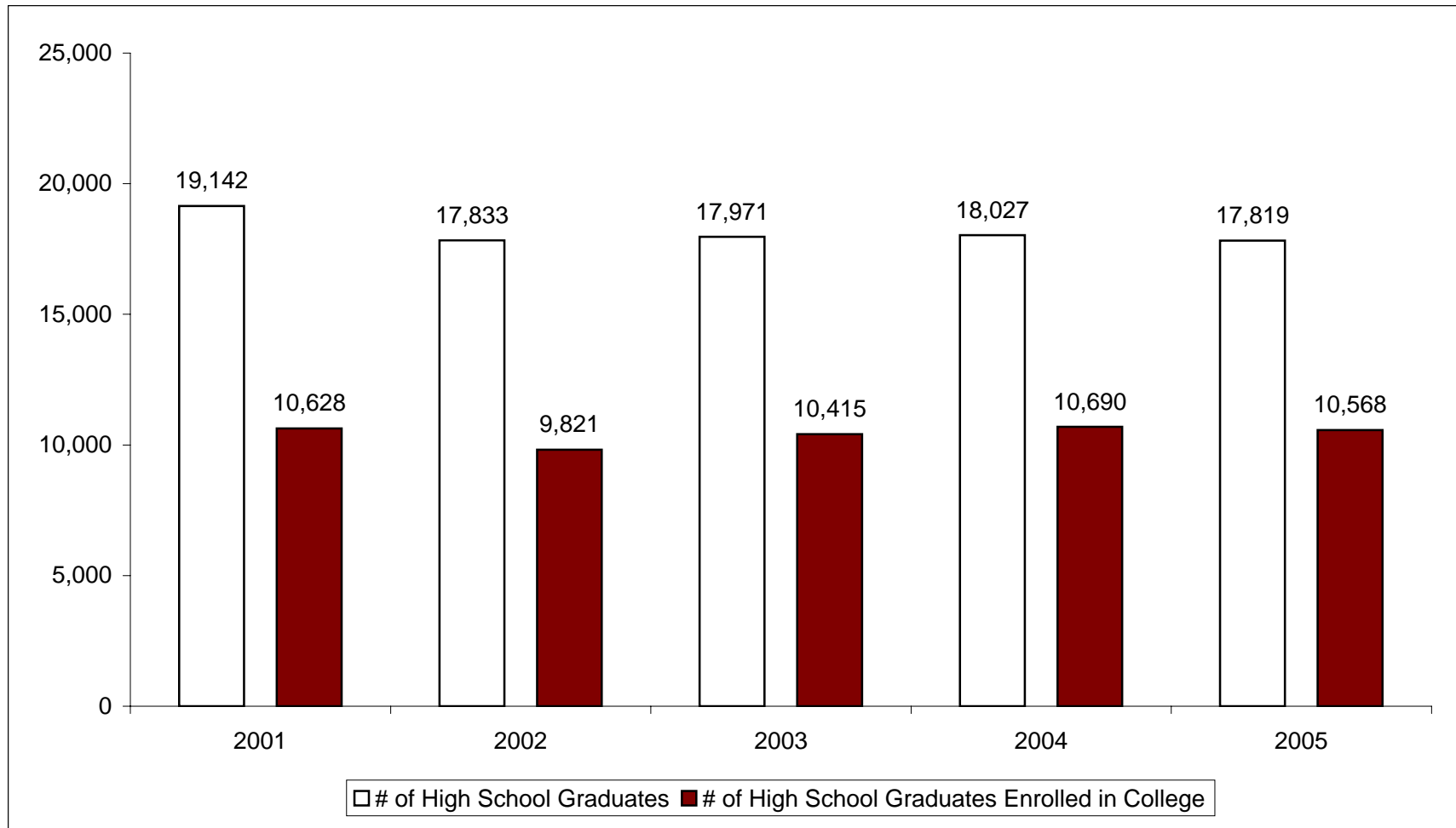

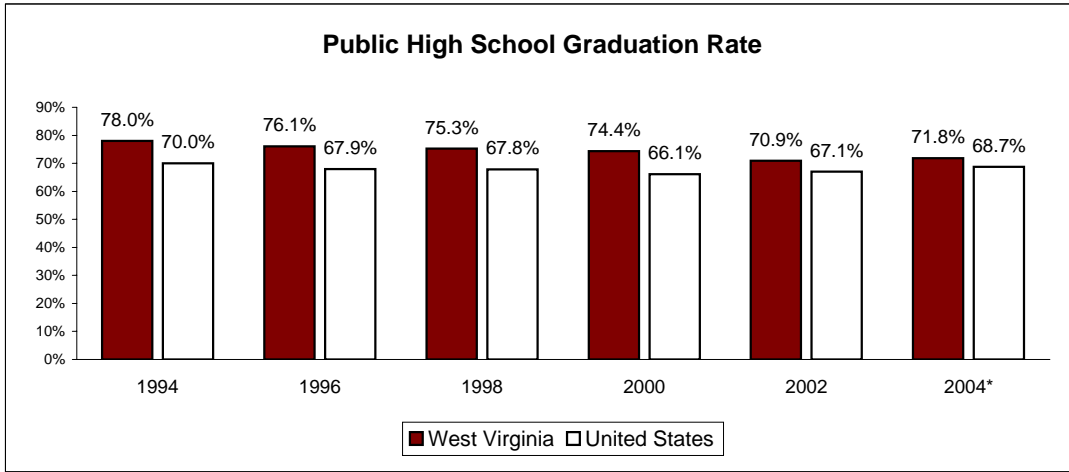

2001-2005**



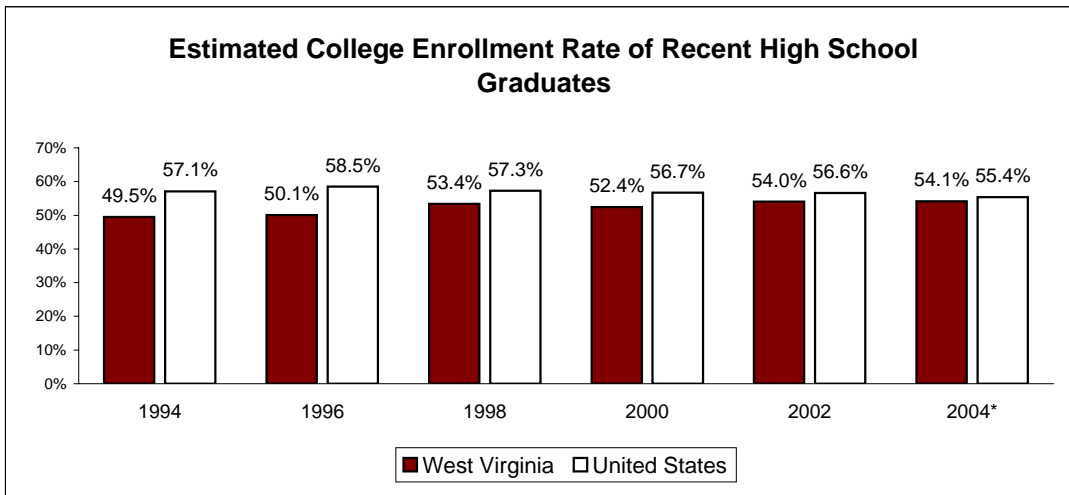

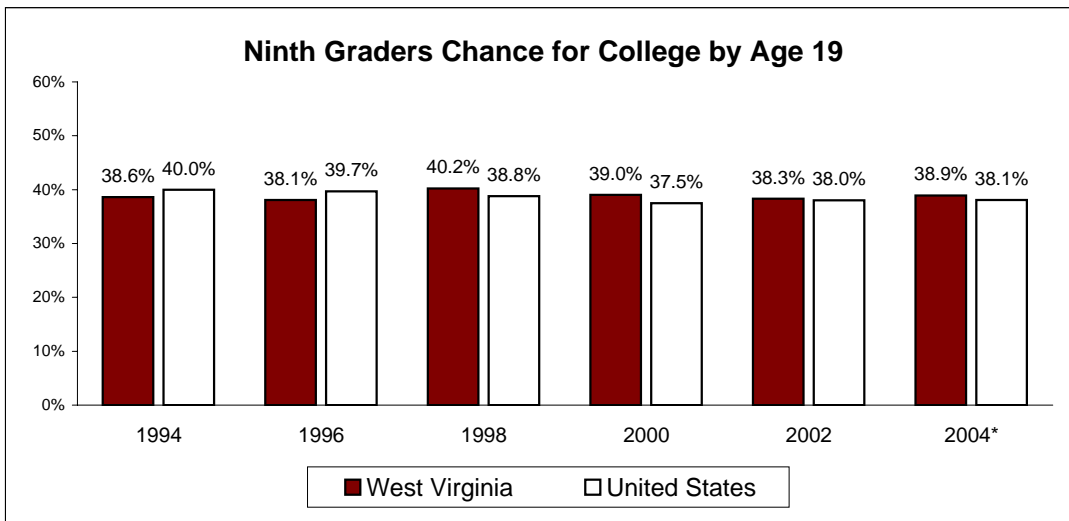
