INTRODUCTION

Again this year, the Office of Planning, Information Management, and Policy Analysis of the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission (WVHEPC) has completed a study of West Virginia college going rates by county and high school. Many thanks go to the college and universities, high schools, county superintendents, and the West Virginia Department of Education who worked so hard to get us the data needed for the report.

The improvement of literacy rates, educational levels and college going rates are important goals for all of us in West Virginia, and in particular, for all levels of the educational system. The attached report shows that progress in college going rates is being made and that the hard work and dedication, not only of those in the educational system, but of the Governor, legislators, government agencies, and parents is making a difference. However, the progress is slow and hard-won and must be diligently and constantly attended to if continuing progress is to be made. We hope the attached report contributes in some small way to this effort by documenting progress and identifying areas for increased efforts.



West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2002

- Of the 17,833 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2001-02, an estimated 10,081 (56.53%) enrolled in higher education institutions in the Fall 2002 semester. This reflects a .16% increase over 2001's rate of 56.37%.
- 8,295 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (39.28%), independent (4.69%), or degree-granting proprietary (2.55%) colleges or universities. This generates an in-state college going rate of 46.51%. **This is a 1.75% increase over last year's figure of 44.76%.**
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in Fall 2002, it is estimated that another 1,786 (10.02%) were attending a college or university in another state. This reflects a 1.59% decrease from 2001's figure of 11.61%.
- The most current national data show that in 2000, the college enrollment rate for high school graduates in the United States was 57%, compared to 52% for West Virginia. However, the high school graduation rate was 74% for West Virginia, compared to 66% for the nation.
- Due to West Virginia's high rate of high school completion, 39% of West Virginia's ninth graders attend college within four years. This exceeds the national rate of 38%.

Source: West Virginia's college going rate is based on high school graduate figures received from the West Virginia Department of Education, estimated enrollment of these high school graduates in out-of-state institutions of higher education received from the county superintendents, and fall data submitted to the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission from the undergraduate, degree-granting institutions of higher education in West Virginia. Students attending other types of postsecondary education are *not* included.



Fall 1998 to Fall 2002



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

West Virginia High School Graduates and Graduates Enrolling in College 1998-2002




