INTRODUCTION

Every year, the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission's Division of Policy and Planning compiles a listing of West Virginia's college going rates by county and high school. This report would not be possible without the gracious hard work and contributions from the colleges and universities, high schools, county superintendents, and the West Virginia Department of Education.

The improvement of literacy rates, educational levels, and college going rates are important goals for the betterment of the State and its economy. The college going rate echoes the successes of the Governor, legislators, government agencies, students, and parents in contributing to the State's education system as a whole. Success in this area is hard-won through diligence and constant attention. The attached report makes an effort to document progress to identify areas for continued efforts for improvement.


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West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2010

- Of the 18,290 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2009-10, an estimated 10,753 **(58.8%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the fall 2010 semester. This represents **a decrease of 2.7 percentage points in the overall rate** since last year. Every sector of higher education experienced a decrease, except for the independent colleges and universities in the state, which showed no change from last year.
- 9,202 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (44.7%), independent (4.7%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.0%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 50.3%**, which represents **a decrease of 2.1 percentage points over last year's figure**.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in fall 2010, it is estimated that another 1,551 **(8.5%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects a decrease of a little over a half of a percentage point over last year's figure.



2006-2010






