INTRODUCTION



West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2008

- Of the 18,222 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2007-08, an estimated 10,708 (58.8%) enrolled in higher education institutions in the fall 2008 semester. This represents a 1.3% increase in the overall rate since last year. Decreases were witnessed by the WV public two-year and WV independent institutions, while increases were noted in the WV public four-year, WV degree-granting proprietary, and out-of-state institutions. The number of WV high school graduates rose by 1.7%.
- 9,132 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (44.9%), independent (4.1%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.1%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 50.1%**, which represents **a 1.3% increase over last year's figure.**
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in fall 2008, it is estimated that another 1,576 (8.6%) were attending a college or university in another state. This reflects almost no change over last year's figure.



Note:



Figure 2 WEST VIRGINIA ESTIMATED COLLEGE GOING RATE By Higher Education Component Fall 2004 to Fall 2008





West Virginia High School Graduates and Graduates Enrolling in College 2004-2008






