INTRODUCTION



West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2011

- Of the 18,001 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2010-11, an estimated 10,423 (57.9%) enrolled in higher education institutions in the fall 2011 semester. This represents a decrease of 0.9 of a percentage point in the overall rate since last year. West Virginia public and degree-granting proprietary institutions experienced increases, while West Virginia independent and out-of-state institutions experienced decreases in their rates.
- 9,039 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (45.1%), independent (4.1%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.0%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 50.2%**, which represents a **decrease of 0.1** of a percentage point over last year's figure.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in fall 2011, it is estimated that another 1,384 (7.7%) were attending a college or university in another state. This reflects a decrease of 0.8 of a percentage point over last year's figure.



West Virginia High School Graduates and Graduates Enrolling in College 2007-2011






