At least one of those professional references should be a faculty member or director of your graduate program (as applicable). If you are a graduate student, please note the date of expected graduation from your program in your resume or CV. Please provide a professional writing sample that showcases your work. For example, a program evaluation, a policy brief, a white paper, a published or unpublished scholarly paper, or other work of which you are the sole or primary author may be provided. In addition, on a separate page, please answer the following questions:

- 1. Describe your background in health care, workforce, or economic development including any experience in data collection, analysis, policy development, and/or advocacy. Why do you think these experiences make you a good fit for this fellowship?**
- 2. Describe your preferences for working as a team vs. working independently. How have your experiences informed your preferences?**
- 3. Discuss a relationship you have had with a mentor in your education or career. How has that mentorship shaped you? How do you best interact with a mentor?**
- 4. How will participation in this fellowship help you to reach your career goals?**

**5. What else would you like the selection committee to know about your interest in this program?**
