Concord University extends its thanks to the vendors who have submitted questions about our Cleaning Services RFB. Below is a list of answers to the questions that we received.

- 1. Is the University setting a minimum pay rate for custodians? or will this decision be the responsibility of the Custodial contractor?
  - a. Pay Rate is WV minimum wage at \$8.75
- 2. Are there Custodial Day Porters? If so how many?
  - a. Yes, there are 2 Porters.
- 3. Is the RFB for Custodial Services labor, equipment and supplies?
  - a. Yes, the RFB is for Custodial Services labor, equipment and supplies.
- 4. Is the 5 year contract a fixed price or can each year have cost of living increases?
  - a. It is not a fixed price and will allow for cost increases.
- 5. Instruction to bidder PAGE 2 is states bid opening date and time: Monday, September 9<sup>th</sup> at 2:00PM. Is this correct?
  - a. No, that is not correct. It is Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup> at 2:00PM. It also has been corrected and reposted.
- 6. What is the timeline schedule for cleaning dorm rooms? Are the dorm rooms cleaned when requested throughout the year when a student moves out of room? And are all rooms detailed cleaned during the summer months? Cleaning specifications state annually.
  - a. The timeline is as follows:
    - i. Mill Street apartments need to be deep cleaned within the Sunday after commencement and following Friday. 6 Day turn around for incoming summer school residents.

- ii. 174 dorm rooms to be deep cleaned within the Sunday after commencement to June 15<sup>th</sup> (30 days) turn around for JROTC and Upward Bound Students.
- iii. 80 Dorm Rooms to be deep cleaned within the Sunday after commencement to the middle of July for sports camp.
- b. Dorm rooms cleaned as requested throughout the year and on average 75 per year.
- c. All dorm rooms are detailed during the summer months, this includes bathroom, foyer, closet, and 2 separate bedrooms; around 800 square feet per suite.
- d. The dorms will be detailed cleaned annually during the summer as specified above.
