The February Month of Service will seek to alleviate various areas of hardship faced by our communities. We hope to address the four following areas of emphasis:

- Food Insecurity

- Literacy and Education
- Community service back to our respective communities

To address these areas, we will seek donations from our students, faculty, staff, alumni, and community members to benefit the following regional charities and locations,

Food drives at each campus will seek the following non-perishables:

- Canned fruits and vegetables
- Dry pasta
- Jellies, jams, and sauces
- Granola or protein bars

- Low-sugar cereals
- Shelf-stable milk
- Grains
- Mac and cheese
- Can openers

Hygiene drives at each campus will seek the following:

- Toilet paper
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Body wash/soap/deodorant
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, and mouthwash
- Towels and washcloths
- Menstrual products (pads, tampons, etc.)
- Acne cream/wipes
- Shaving supplies/lotion
- Baby wipes/diapers
- Nail files/clippers
- Sunblock

Book drives at each campus will seek the following:

- Gently used new picture and board books appropriate for babies through elementary school students, and graphic novels
