





# **High School Counselors & Financial Aid Staff**

- Students are unclear about what they are eligible for, and the requirements of each program should they receive an award.
  - Specific example: Invests Program Drug Testing
    - Timing within 60 days of start
    - Cost \$45
    - Results .45% test positive ('25-'26) / .46% ('24 '25)
- Students say they would like a single source/application where they can get all relevant information in simple language and be able to track application progress.
