**Higher education plays a primary role in building a thriving economy and strengthening our state's competitiveness and long-term prosperity. That is why everything that we do is focused on improving our college-going rate here in West Virginia.**

We are working to arm 60 percent of the Mountain State's workforce with a formal credential beyond high school by 2030 – nearly doubling the percentage of working-age West Virginians with a postsecondary education. This effort is collaborative and involves K-12 education, business and industry partners, and higher education institutions working together to ensure that students are exposed to opportunities early and supported even before they make their postsecondary decisions. Our job is to remove barriers – both real and perceived – so that we can support our future workforce where they are and propel them forward to be successful in both today's economy and the future economy.

We have so much to celebrate in our mission to move college accessibility and affordability forward. We continue to see progress with our very successful LevelUp – high school dual enrollment – program. More than 8,000 high school students across the state are now taking dual enrollment courses and we're seeing that once they take a college course or courses, they are likely to stay enrolled in higher education.

Recently, West Virginia was also recognized by the National College Attainment Network for our increase in FAFSA completion among high school seniors. We were able to rise to 15th in the nation, with almost 50 percent of students completing the FAFSA. That was up from 17th last year. We were credited with

– and can affirm – that this was due to a “well-coordinated ecosystem of support” that includes multiple local and state partnerships.

Our WV Invests program – which offers tuition-free community college for in-demand programs – is improving graduation rates without debt. For students getting one-year certificates, since WV Invests was created, the percentage of students graduating without debt has gone from 46 percent to 64 percent. For associate degrees, the percentage of students graduating without debt has gone from 44 percent to 56 percent. And those numbers continue to increase year after year.

We also understand that the traditional higher education model is not for everyone and West Virginia is on the national forefront of microcredentialing – expanding access to stackable, skills-based credentials that help students meet their local workforce needs. These short, focused learning experiences give adults valuable, job-ready competencies that can be applied immediately in the workforce.

# 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

## LAUNCH OF STATEWIDE STAND PROGRAM, SUPPORTING SKILLED TRADE WORKERS

With support from the legislature in 2025, we launched the STAND program in fall 2025. The STAND Program enables West Virginia residents, who are in an apprenticeship or are a journey worker, to complete the courses necessary to receive an associate degree. This path means that eligible West Virginians can go from apprenticeship to degree, tuition-free, at participating community colleges. With more than 150 applications to date, we look forward to watching this program's continued growth.

## HIGH SCHOOL DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM GROWTH

The state's dual enrollment initiative, LevelUpWV, continues to expand access to higher education for high school students. West Virginia's public community and technical colleges and four-year institutions are offering courses in certain designated career pathways for free to help meet workforce demands. The dual enrollment program grew by more than 12 percent since fall 2024, with more than 8,000 high school students across the state now taking dual enrollment courses through LevelUpWV.



# FAFSA COMPLETION GAINS EXPAND COLLEGE ACCESS IN WEST VIRGINIA, RANKING IN TOP 15 NATIONALLY

During the 2024–25 FAFSA cycle, West Virginia emerged as a national leader in helping students access financial aid for college. The state ranked among the top 15 in the nation for FAFSA completion, reaching as high as 10th nationally, according to the National College Attainment Network. This progress reflects coordinated, student-centered efforts led by the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission in partnership with schools, counselors, and communities statewide.

Unlike many high-performing states, West Virginia achieved these gains without a statewide FAFSA mandate. Instead, the state built a culture of completion through strategic outreach, data-informed coordination, and intentional engagement. Initiatives such as WV FAFSA Day, school-based completion challenges, targeted text outreach, and enhanced tools for counselors helped nearly half of West Virginia's graduating seniors complete the FAFSA, expanding access to the financial aid that makes education after high school more affordable and attainable.

## MORE THAN 70 HIGH SCHOOLS RECOGNIZED FOR EFFORTS TO HELP STUDENTS PLAN FOR COLLEGE

More than 70 West Virginia high schools were recognized for their efforts to help students plan for college. This shows incredible growth over last year's 42 high school champions.

### 2024-25 Aggregated Impact

- Over 70 high schools recognized statewide as CFWV College Access and Success Champions
- Double-digit FAFSA completion increases achieved by dozens of Champion schools
- FAFSA completion gains of more than 20 percentage points at multiple schools
- Several schools exceeded 70 percent FAFSA completion, with some surpassing 90 percent
- 5,550 college applications submitted during College Application & Exploration Week (CAEW) at Champion schools
- 3,395 students submitted at least one college application during CAEW
- Over 36,000 students across grades 9-12 engaged through CAEW activities
- 1,247 parents and guardians participated in CAEW and College Decision Day events
- Widespread College Decision Day participation, with many schools reporting near-universal senior involvement



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



2024-25 Academic Year | Summer, Fall and Spring End-of-Term Data

This list reflects the five most common fields of study based on the total number of undergraduate and graduate degrees awarded within an academic year. Fields of study are categorized using the U.S. Department of Education's Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) codes and associated disciplines.

### STUDENT TO FACULTY RATIO

2023-24 Academic Year | Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS)

This metric is calculated by dividing total full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment for students not enrolled in graduate or professional programs by total FTE for instructional staff not teaching in graduate or professional programs.

This measure reflects the percentage of the institution's total annualized headcount enrollment that is comprised of high school students enrolled in college classes while still in high school.

### FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT (FTE) ENROLLMENT

2024-25 Academic Year | Summer, Fall and Spring End-of-Term Data

Annualized Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment values represent the sum of all credit hours generated by undergraduate students enrolled in credit-bearing classes, divided by 30, and the sum of credit hours generated by graduate students in credit-bearing classes, divided by 24, during the summer, fall and spring terms in a given academic year at a specific institution.

### FALL FRESHMAN CLASS PROFILE

2024-25 Academic Year | Fall End-of-term Data

This section provides a summary of the academic and demographic characteristics of first-time, full- and part-time, associate or bachelor's degree-seeking freshmen matriculating in the fall semester of an academic year. Featured characteristics include gender, race/ethnicity, West Virginia residency status, percentage scoring at or above college-ready benchmarks in the English and Math sections of the SAT (based only on those freshmen who submitted SAT scores), percentage receiving financial aid through the West Virginia PROMISE Scholarship or federal Pell Grant programs, and the percentage who earned college credit while in high school through programs such as dual enrollment, Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB).

### UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT PROFILE

### MINORITY STUDENTS

This indicator reflects the percentage of first-time full-time freshmen in a fall entry cohort who enrolled in the spring semester of the same academic year at the same institution.

## **FRESHMEN COMPLETING 30 HOURS**

Fall 2024 First-Time Full-Time Freshman Cohort | Summer, Fall and Spring End-of-Term Data

This indicator reflects the percentage of first-time full-time freshmen in a fall entry cohort who successfully completed 30 credit hours by the end of the following summer.

## **BACHELOR'S GRADUATION RATES (FOUR- AND SIX-YEAR)**

Fall 2019 First-Time Full-Time Freshman Cohort | Summer, Fall and Spring End-of-Term Data

This indicator reflects the percentage of first-time full-time bachelor's degree-seeking freshmen in a fall entry cohort who earned a bachelor's degree at any public West Virginia institution within four and six years of initial enrollment.

## **DEGREES AWARDED**

2024-25 Academic Year | Summer, Fall and Spring End-of-Term Data

These values represent the total number of academic credentials at the certificate, associate, bachelor's, master's, post-master's certificate, and doctoral levels awarded by an institution within an academic year. Students earning multiple credentials within an academic year are counted more than once.

## **GRADUATING CLASS PROFILE**

2024-25 Graduates | Summer, Fall and Spring End-of-Term Data

This section provides a summary of the academic and demographic characteristics of all bachelor's degree recipients within an academic year. The values for Potomac State College of WVU reflect associate degree earners. Gender, minority status and West Virginia residency status reflect all graduates. Academic characteristics including average college GPA, years to degree, and credit hours earned are calculated only for graduates who are earning their first bachelor's degree, have no prior associate degree or higher, and have started as a first-time freshman at any public in-state institution.

## **FINANCIAL AID PARTICIPATION RATE**

2024-25 Academic Year | Summer, Fall and Spring End-of-Term Data

This measure represents the percentage of students (excluding dual enrolled students) receiving federal, state, or institutional grants or waivers divided by the annual unduplicated headcount for the year, excluding dual enrollment. It does not include veterans' benefits, vocational rehabilitation benefits, other educational benefits, or loans, but does include work study. In 2024-25, with additional funding, the maximum award for the WV Higher Education Grant was doubled from \$3,400 to \$6,800.

## **GRADUATE INDEBTEDNESS**

This section provides data on the percentage of bachelor's degree earners within an academic year who graduated with student loan debt, along with the average total student loan debt that accumulated as of the student's graduation date. These wages do not include graduates who are employed outside of West Virginia, are self-employed, did not earn wages in each of the four quarters of the calendar year, are clergy, are members of the military, or work for the federal government. To protect student privacy, workforce data may be suppressed or unpublished for institutions with small numbers of graduates in the workforce.
